



## **Non-Residential Program Refunded Proposed Changes November 2011**

Per Senate Bill 585, the Non-Residential programs for CCSE and PG&E will be reopened and funded once the California Public Utilities Commission releases the Final Decision, which will provide Program Administrators with direction on implementation. In addition to refunding the program, this Final Decision will specify new PBI rates for all sectors for Steps 8, 9, & 10. All EPBB incentive rates will remain the same. The proposed PBI rates are below:

	<b>Residential/Commercial with 4% Discount Rate</b>	<b>Government/Non-Profit with 4% Discount Rate</b>
Step 8	\$0.044	\$0.139
Step 9	\$0.032	\$0.114
Step 10	\$0.025	\$0.088

The new PBI rates will be effective for all new reservations and for projects on the Wait List at the time the Final Decision is released. In addition, the rates will apply to any PBI project system size increases moving forward.

The new rates stated in the Final Decision will be posted on the Trigger Tracker website and utilized in the EPBB calculator and PowerClerk. In PowerClerk, Steps 8 and 9 will be shown as Step 8a & 8b and Step 9a & 9b.

The new PBI rates will go into effect the day after the Final Decision is released. Due to the urgent need for the reinstatement of funding into the CSI Program, CCSE anticipates that the Final Decision will be released expeditiously.
