

APPLICANT AND VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FORM

Alternative fuel vehicle rebates are funded by the California Air Resources Board, offered throughout the state of California and administered by the California Center for Sustainable Energy (CCSE). For requirements and instructions, please visit www.fuelingalts.energycenter.org.

Applicant and vehicle eligibility requirements are specified in the California Air Resources Board (ARB) Alternative Fuel Vehicle Incentive Program (AFVIP) guidelines (Guidelines) that are available on the Fueling Alternatives Web site. Applicants must be an individual, or a federal, state, regional or local government entity or agency, organization or company. For a leased vehicle, the applicant shall be the lessee. Vehicles meeting the requirements specified in Section 3.2 of the Guidelines will be included in the list of eligible vehicles available on the Fueling Alternatives Web site: www.fuelingalts.energycenter.org.

Applicants must meet requirements that include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. The applicant is a resident of the State of California or represents an entity that conducts business in the State of California.
2. The applicant has purchased or is leasing a new alternative fuel vehicle (AFV) or plug in hybrid vehicle (PHEV) that meets the criteria as described below.
3. The purchase or lease of this new vehicle commenced on or after May 24, 2007 and the California Center for Sustainable Energy (CCSE) received the application package on or before March 31, 2009 or before funding is no longer available, whichever comes first.
4. This new vehicle is registered with the California Department of Motor Vehicles for at least 36 months for use in California.¹

Vehicles must meet requirements that include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. The vehicle is a new alternative fuel vehicle (AFV) or plug in hybrid vehicle (PHEV) that meets the criteria specified in Section 3.2 of the Guidelines.
2. The vehicle is new as defined in California Vehicle Code Section 430. Vehicles considered new vehicles solely for determination of compliance with state emissions standards pursuant to Health and Safety Code, Article 1.5, Prohibited Transactions, (Sections 43150-43156) and CVC Section 4000.2, Registration of Out-of-State Vehicles, are not eligible vehicles.
3. The vehicle model, with the exception of Zero Emission Motorcycles (ZEMs), has been certified by the ARB as a new AFV or has received an experimental permit to operate as an advanced technology demonstration program vehicle. The vehicle model must also comply with all applicable federal safety standards for new motor vehicles and new motor vehicle equipment issued by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.
4. ZEMs and Neighborhood Electric Vehicles (NEVs) must be equipped with sealed, maintenance-free batteries and meet the warranty requirements as described in section 3.2.2 of the Guidelines.

APPLICANT AND VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS CONTINUED...

You will receive your rebate directly in a single allotment. If you intend to lease a new vehicle and the lease period is less than 36 months, you must contact the Program Administrator for confirmation of vehicle eligibility and rebate amount.

Complete and submit the following items to the Program Administrator:

- A completed Application Form MSCD/AFV-02A (If multiple vehicle rebates are requested, Form MSCD/AFV-02B may be completed and attached to Form MSCD/AFV-02A.)
- A copy of the lease/purchase agreement signed by all parties with an itemization of credits, discounts and incentives received, if applicable
- A copy of the current vehicle registration (Temporary registration is acceptable.)
- For individuals, a copy of a current utility billing statement
- For select NEVs as identified on the eligible vehicle list, evidence of sealed maintenance-free batteries and a 24-month warranty per section 3.2.2 of the program guidelines

Rebate eligibility assumes the vehicle is owned for a continuous 36 month period after the date of purchase or lease. As such, you are required to provide the Program Administrator with your new address if you change addresses during the three-year period after the date of purchase or lease. If you decide to sell the vehicle or terminate the lease with the prescribed period, please contact the Program Administrator.

PRIVACY STATEMENT

Section 7(b) of the Privacy Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-5791) requires that any federal, state, or local governmental agency which requests an individual to disclose his/her social security account number shall inform that individual whether that disclosure is mandatory or voluntary, by which statutory or other authority such number is solicited, and what uses will be made of it.

The State of California requires that all parties entering into business transactions that may lead to payments from the State must provide their Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) as required by the State Revenue and Taxation Code, Section 18646 to facilitate tax compliance enforcement activities and to facilitate the preparation of Form 1099 and other information as required by the Internal Revenue Code, Section 6109(a). The TIN for individual and sole proprietorships is the Social Security Number (SSN).

It is mandatory to furnish the information requested. Federal law requires that payments for which the requested information is not provided be subject to 31% withholding and state law imposes noncompliance penalties of up to \$20,000.
