ELECTRIC VEHICLE DAY – San Diego: a National Drive Electric Week event

Where and when is ELECTRIC VEHICLE DAY?

Sat., Sept. 20, 2014, 10:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

How much does it cost?

The event is free and open to the public.

Do I need to register?

Registration is not required, but it is preferred. Please register at:

www.energycenter.org/EVDay.

Where can I park?

If you are driving an EV to the event we have a special parking area for you to put your car on display. If you are driving a non-EV to the event there is street parking and many lots in the area. Please do not park in the Vons or Trader Joe's lots.

Where do I enter the event after I park?

The event is in the Liberty Station Vons and Trader Joe's parking lot, on Truxtun Road, in between Roosevelt Road and Womble Road. Look for the registration tent to sign your liability waiver and show your drivers' license before taking a test drive.

What do I need to bring with me to test-drive an electric vehicle?

We will need to see your driver's license and have you sign a waiver before you can get behind the wheel.

What is the minimum age to drive a vehicle?

You must be 21 years or older to test-drive a vehicle.

Can teens or kids of any age ride as passengers?

Yes, they can be in the vehicle while you take the test drive.

What else will be at the event?

There will be booths where you can learn about electric vehicle charging, incentives, electricity rates, and solar. Many local residents will have their electric cars on display and you are welcome to visit this area of the event and ask the owners questions.

Will there be food?

There will not be food sold at the event, however yards away are great grab-and-go or sit-down restaurants, as well as Vons and Trader Joes grocery stores.

FOR ELECTRIC VEHICLE DRIVERS ONLY:

Do I need to register to park my EV at the event?

Registration is preferred. Please register at www.energycenter.org/EVDay. Space is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Do I need a special confirmation to attend with my car?

No, you do not need a confirmation or a ticket, but you will receive an e-mail closer to the event if you register. The event is free and open to the public, so bring family and friends too.

Exactly where do I bring my vehicle and park it?

Parking is available for all EVs and plug-in hybrid EVs on a first-come, first-served basis within the event space. When you arrive in your vehicle, please pull into the event in the Trader Joe's parking lot and volunteers will guide you to a parking location.

Can I bring my vehicle at any time during the event hours?

The event starts at 10 a.m. We recommend arriving early to get a space at the largest gathering of EVs in San Diego.

Can I leave at any time during the event?

Yes, you will be able to leave at any time, but we encourage you to stay and experience the event, plus talk to community members interested in neighbors like you who drive EVs. As part of the event, there is a ride-n-drive available for you to test-drive more than a dozen types of EVs and plug-in hybrid EVs.

Is charging available for my EV?

Yes, there are 10 240-volt charging stations two blocks away on Cushing Road. Use your Plugshare or Blink app to see which ones are available for your use. (Please be aware that the 10 stations located in the Trader Joe's parking lot are for use by our event test drive vehicles only.)
